**RESOLUTION TO EXPAND EMPLOYMENT OF SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS  
CONSISTENT WITH AM. SUB. HOUSE BILL 409 (2021-1133)**

Dr. Page moved to approve the following:

Pursuant to the authority granted in Section 3 of Amended Substitute House Bill 409 of the 133rd General Assembly, signed by Governor DeWine on or about January 7, 2021, the Clark-Shawnee Local School District Board of Education ("Board") authorizes the employment of substitute teachers, as-needed, who do not hold a post-secondary degree, as otherwise required pursuant to Ohio law and regulations, including Ohio Revised Code 3319.226 and 3319.30, Ohio Administrative Code Section 3301-23-44, and/or Board Policy, provided that all other applicable requirements and procedures, including successful completion of a criminal background check and evidence of a non-renewable temporary substitute teaching license issued by the Ohio Department of Education, have been satisfied. The Board also authorizes the District to pay for the non-renewable temporary substitute teaching license for current employees of the District who are requested to obtain this license by the Superintendent. This is a temporary resolution of the Board, and the authority granted by this resolution extends from the effective date through June 30, 2021.
