FAIRBORN ART ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Fairborn Art Association awards three \$1,000.00 scholarships to deserving seniors in the Arts program at area high schools who plan to further their education at an accredited art school or college.

To be considered for the scholarship the following criteria must be met:

1. Student must show a serious intent to pursue a career in art and demonstrate exceptional art talent and skills.
2. Student must be a graduating senior in an area high school and have a written recommendation by his/her art instructor.
3. Student must complete this application and return it with written recommendation and color photos (will accept digital photos on a CD) of his/her work to the Fairborn Art Association, P.O. Box 1231, Fairborn, Ohio, 45324, no later than April 10.

The F.A.A. (Fairborn Art Association) Board of Directors will determine scholarship winners by the end of April. Award winners will be notified by the President or a member of the Board of Directors shortly thereafter. Winners will be presented with their awards and checks during a regularly scheduled meeting. If a recipient decides not to pursue art studies, then his/her scholarship will be forfeited and that scholarship will be awarded to the runner-up in the competition. The F.A.A. is awarding this scholarship as a goodwill benefit to the community; therefore, the Fairborn Art Association will accept no liability with the award process. The judgment of the F.A.A. Board in making the decision is final.
